Dear Customer,

Enclosed you will find the following information: Page 1- a list and description of the 2006 hybrids that we have for sale. Page 2- our 2005 test plot results and test plot data descriptions. The 2005 season had many challenges for our test plot and field tests. The season started slowly with cool days and above average rainfall in May. We had a few heavy rains just after planting which gave us a crusting problem, followed by some windy days. In late June we were short on growing degree units. During pollination the summer returned with above average heat. We picked up a lot of growing degree units in a short amount of time in August. The August nights in our growing zone and area our normally cool, leading to great expression in yield and quality. This August we experienced many abnormally warm nights leading to added stress on the plants. It was a very dry August and fall which led to a rapid dry down after black layer was reached. These variations and conditions brought yield and quality potentials down, but allowed us good selection pressures. Page 2 details individual hybrid responses to these conditions.

During the 2005 Seedsmen Field Days many of you participated in our "Guess the Mystery Hybrid" challenge. Six people correctly picked the mystery hybrid (N11649); and one winner was picked (LuAnn Opheim). LuAnn will receive 500 lbs. of seed.
